Charlottenborg Spring Exhibition 2017 Aase Seidler Gernes solo exhibition

Aase Seidler Gernes was a prominent textile designer in the 1950s and 1960s due to her geometrical compositions in fashionable colours. A selection of works from her long oeuvre is exhibited in the form of tapestries, tablecloths and unique clothing.

In collaboration with her husband Poul Gernes, she created curtains for Herlev Hospital in the 1970s; these curtains are shown here in front of the windows. The exhibition also includes a series of new colourful drawings executed in felt-tip pens on paper.

Seidler Gernes created these even though a stroke left her paralysed in the right side of the body in 2007. She subsequently trained her left hand to draw, making it possible for her to continue to express herself artistically.
