

## BIG ART

"Vores kreative samarbejder med kunstnere fra hele verden har været nogle af de mest betydningsfulde øjeblikke i vores arkitektoniske eventyr, og vi ønsker at fejre dem i denne udstilling, hvor de besøgende kan opleve installationerne i den skala som de er tiltænkt at blive set." – Bjarke Ingels

Udstillingen *BIG ART*er Kunsthals Charlottenborgs hidtil mest omfangsrike udstilling af samtidskunst i stor skala. Udstillingen viser kunsten i BIG-Bjarke Ingels Groups arkitektur over hele verden. Udstillingens titel *BIG ART* skal forstås på to måder: at alle kunstnerne på udstillingen er kurateret ud fra deres samarbejde med tegnestuen BIG, og at der er tale om en udstilling af kunst i stor skala, hvor værkerne vil blive vist i den størrelse på kunsthallen, som de oprindeligt er tænkt til bygninger og byrum.

Kunsthals Charlottenborgs 1000 kvadratmeter store sydfløj bliver omdannet til arkitektoniske miljøer, hvor man kan opleve det originale hus fra Lars von Tiers seneste film *The House That Jack Built* tegnet af Bjarke Ingels samt BIGs kreative samarbejder med: A Kassen, Victor Ash, Douglas Coupland, Es Devlin, Shepard Fairey, Peter Funch, Julie Edel Hardenberg, Jeppe Hein, HuskMitNavn, John Kørner, Benoit Maire, Tomás Saraceno, Kaspar Astrup Schröder, Snarkitecture, SUPERFLEX, Martin de Thurah, Lars von Trier, Andrew Zuckerman, Ai Weiwei. Udstillingen er kurateret af Michael Thouber.

The exhibition *BIG ART* constitutes Kunsthals Charlottenborg's most comprehensive exhibition of large-scale contemporary art to date. The exhibition presents art works envisioned for BIG-Bjarke Ingels Group's buildings and urban projects globally. The exhibition title, *BIG ART*, has a dual meaning: every artist featured has been chosen on the basis of their collaboration with BIG and at the same time the exhibition presents art on a large scale, showing each individual piece at the original size envisioned for its intended urban setting.

The show transforms the 1,000 m<sup>2</sup> south wing of Kunsthals Charlottenborg into a series of architectural settings where visitors can experience the original house from Lars von Trier's latest film *The House That Jack Built* created by Bjarke Ingels, along with BIG's creative collaborations with: A Kassen, Victor Ash, Douglas Coupland, Es Devlin, Shepard Fairey, Peter Funch, Julie Edel Hardenberg, Jeppe Hein, HuskMitNavn, John Kørner, Benoit Maire, Tomás Saraceno, Kaspar Astrup Schröder, Snarkitecture, SUPERFLEX, Martin de Thurah, Lars von Trier, Andrew Zuckerman, Ai Weiwei. The exhibition is curated by Michael Thouber.

# ALICJA KWADE

## *Out of Ousia*

21 Sep – 17 Feb 2019

Kunsthall Charlottenborg præsenterer den første store udstilling i Danmark med den polskfødte kunstkommet Alicja Kwade (f. 1979). Gennem det seneste årti har Kwade vundet global opmærksomhed og sikret sig en prominent plads på den internationale samtidskunstscene.

Den internationalt anerkendte kunstners poetiske skulpturlandskaber består ofte af kendte objekter og materialer fra naturen, som fratages deres vante funktion og opfører sig anderledes end de plejer: Småsten er slebet som var de diamanter, kul er forklædt som guldbarrer og grene, glas og kobber rejser sig fra jorden og ophæver tyngdekraften. Naturens fysiske love sættes ud af spil, og Alicja Kwade tager os ind i sin bøjede virkelighed, som både er genkendelig og fremmed, nær og fjern, virkelig og uvirkeligt.

Gennem kunsten stiller Alicja Kwade spørgsmål til vores forståelse af abstrakte størrelser som tid, rum og lysets natur, til fysikkens love, naturvidenskabens gåder og til sociale konventioner, som er grundsten i vores virkelighedsforståelse. Hun rejser disse store spørgsmål på en let, poetisk og humoristisk måde, som gør én både nysgerrig, forundret og underholdt. Udstillingen er kurateret af Marie Nipper.

Kunsthall Charlottenborg presents the first major exhibition in Denmark by the acclaimed Polish-born artist Alicja Kwade (b. 1979). During the last decade, Kwade has rapidly become a rising star, winning global attention and a prominent place on the international contemporary art scene.

Kwade's poetic sculptural landscapes often consist of familiar objects and commonplace natural materials stripped of their usual function and imbued with new properties and value. Mass, surfaces and materialities act in new ways: pebbles have been cut and polished as if they were diamonds, coal comes disguised as gold bars, and branches, glass and copper rise up from the ground, defying gravity. The laws of nature are suspended as Alicja Kwade draws us into her warped version of reality, which is both recognisable and alien, near and far away, real and unreal.

Alicja Kwade challenges our understanding of abstract concepts such as the nature of time, space and light, the laws of physics, the mysteries of science and the deeply embedded social conventions that form the bedrock of our perception of reality. She raises these big questions in a light-hearted, poetic and humorous way that provokes curiosity, wonder and amusement. The exhibition is curated by Marie Nipper.

BIGERT & BERGSTRÖM  
*Solar Egg*

12 Okt – 13 Jan 2019

I efteråret lander et 5 meter højt guldæg med sauna indeni midt i Kunsthall Charlottenborgs gård. Guldægget med titlen *Solar Egg* er en skulptur skabt af den svenske kunstnerduo Bigert & Bergström (f. hhv. 1965 og 1962).

*Solar Egg* er en social skulptur, hvor både københavnere og besøgende i byen kan mødes. I de nordiske lande indtager saunaen en nøgleposition som et rum for varme og refleksion. Bigert & Bergström har taget denne tradition op og udviklet en symbolisk skulptur, der skal fungere som rum for samtaler og udveksling af ideer. Projektet er en fortsættelse af kunstnernes arbejde med klima i deres værker siden 1994, hvor de skabte en række klimakamre.

*Solar Egg* er af træ, beklædt med et rustfrit, gyldent spejllag, der med dets mangefacetterede form spejler omgivelserne. I midten af ægget står den træopvarmede, hjerteformede saunaovn udført af jern og sten. Temperaturen inde i skulpturen er mellem 75° og 85° C. Det vil være muligt at booke en saunatid tre dage om ugen i udstillingsperioden.

*Solar Egg* af Bigert & Bergström er produceret af Riksbyggen og udstillingen er støttet af Det Obelske Familiefond og Statens Kunstfond.

This fall, a 5 meter tall golden egg with a sauna inside lands in the middle of Kunsthall Charlottenborg's courtyard. The golden egg titled *Solar Egg* is a sculpture created by the Swedish art duo Bigert & Bergström (b. 1965 and 1962).

*Solar Egg* is a social sculpture, where both locals and visitors to Copenhagen can meet. In the Nordic countries, the sauna holds a key position as a space for warmth and reflection. Picking up on this tradition, Bigert & Bergström have developed a symbolic sculpture intended as space for conversations and the exchange of ideas. The project reflects the artists' overall strategy of incorporating the climate in our experience of their art; a recurring trait of their work since they created a series of climate chambers back in 1994.

*Solar Egg* is made of wood and covered in a stainless golden mirror surface whose many facets reflect its surroundings. In the centre of the egg is a wood-fired, heart-shaped sauna stove made of iron and stone. The temperature inside the sculpture is between 75° and 85°C. Visitors will be able to book sauna appointments three days a week during the exhibition period.

*Solar Egg* by Bigert & Bergström is produced by Riksbyggen and the exhibition is supported by the Obel Family Foundation and the Danish Arts Foundation.

# ANGELA MELITOPOULOS

## *Crossings*

22 Nov – 13 Jan 2019

Et mesterværk blev Angela Melitopoulos video- og lydinstallations *Crossings* udråbt til, da det sidste år blev skabt til documenta 14. Det omfattende værk er co-produceret af Kunsthall Charlottenborg og præsenteres nu for første gang i Skandinavien.

*Crossings* skaber en fortælling om krig, om forskellige former for slaveri i fortid og nutid samt om miljømæssige katastrofer. Værket fokuserer på de kaotiske vilkår, der vokser ud af den aktuelle gældskrise i Grækenland, hvor dereguleringer skaber en form for borgerkrig mod landets indbyggere. Krig, ødelæggelse og oplevelsen af en traumatisk neoliberal virkelighed videreføres fra krop til krop, fra generation til generation. I værket høres en endeløs række stemmer, der hæver sig, sammenflettes og danner nye udtryksformer.

*Crossings* er en fire-kanals video- og seksten kanals lydinstallations af Angela Melitopoulos (f. 1961) i samarbejde med komponist Pascal Criton, video-kunstner Angela Anderson, filosof Maurizio Lazzarato, videoaktivist Octay Ince og schizoanalytiker Paula Cobo Guevara.

Experience one of the central art works from last year's documenta exhibition by Angela Melitopoulos. The comprehensive work is co-produced by Kunsthall Charlottenborg and is now presented in Scandinavia for the first time.

*Crossings* composes a narrative about war, forms of slavery past and present and ecological disasters. It focuses on delirious conditions of realities emerging in the current state of debt crisis in Greece, where deregulations create a civil war among its citizens. War, destruction and the experience of a traumatic neoliberal reality is transmitted from body to body, from generation to generation, generating countless voices. These voices are intertwined – they form new groups of expressions.

*Crossings* is a four-channel video and sixteen-channel audio installation by Angela Melitopoulos (b. 1961) in collaboration with music composer Pascal Criton, video artist Angela Anderson, philosopher Maurizio Lazzarato, video activist Octay Ince and schizoanalyst Paula Cobo Guevara.

## Forårsudstillingen / Spring exhibition 2019

2 Feb – 10 Mar 2019

Forårsudstillingen er en af de vigtigste åbne, censurerede udstillinger i Europa og har siden 1857 været en fast del af Kunsthall Charlottenborgs program. En international jury udvælger værker af både nationale og internationale kunstnere fra hele verden indenfor billedkunst, arkitektur og design til den omfangsrike udstilling.

The Spring Exhibition is among the most important open, censored exhibitions in Europe and has been an annual recurring show at Kunsthall Charlottenborg since 1857. An international jury selects works from Danish as well as international artists from all over the world within the genres visual art, architecture and design for the comprehensive exhibition

## CPH:DOX

22 Mar – 19 Maj 2019

Kunsthall Charlottenborg er for 3. år hovedkvarter for en af verdens største dokumentarfilm festivaler, CPH:DOX. Kunsthallen ombygges til lejligheden til internationalt festivalpalæ med biografer, debatter, brancheforum og virtual reality-biograf, men også med udstillinger og særligt kuraterede filmprogrammer.

For the third year Kunsthall Charlottenborg acts as headquarters for one of the world's largest documentary film festivals, CPH:DOX. The exhibition space is converted into an international festival mansion with movie theaters, debates, industry forum and virtual reality theater, but also exhibitions and special film programmes.

## AFGANG / MFA DEGREE SHOW 2019

12 Apr – 19 Maj 2019

Den årligt tilbagevendende eksamsudstilling for dimittenderne fra Kunstakademiet Billedkunstskoler i København præsenterer kunst skabt af helt unge talenter fra Danmarks ældste Kunstakademi, som åbnede dørene i 1754 og i dag viderefører en tradition for at forstre kunstnere af international klasse.

This annual exhibition by graduates from the Schools of Visual Arts at Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts in Copenhagen presents art created by young talent from Denmark's oldest art academy, which opened in 1754 and continues a proud tradition of fostering artists of international stature.

## Jesper Just

14 Jun – 11 Aug 2019

Jesper Justs værk *Servitudes* (2015) er en omfattende videoinstallation bestående af en række kortfilm, der alle har New Yorks nye skyskraber, One World Trade Center, som kulisse. Som erstatning for tvillingetårnene ødelagt den 11. september 2001, synes skyskraberen ikke at kunne ryste fortidens spøgelser af sig. Værket har tidligere været vist på Palais de Tokyo i Paris og er købt til samlingen på Metropolitan Museum of Art i New York. Udstillingen kurateres af Irene Campolmi og produceres i samarbejde med MAAT i Lissabon.

Jesper Just's *Servitudes* (2015) is a comprehensive video installation consisting of a range of short films, which all have New York's new skyscraper, One World Trade Center, as its setting. Replacing the Twin Towers destroyed on 9/11 in 2001, the skyscraper does not seem able to shake off the ghosts of the past. The work has previously been presented at Palais de Tokyo in Paris and is part of the collection of the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York. The exhibition is curated by Irene Campolmi and is produced in collaboration with MAAT in Lisbon.

## Charlottenborg Art Cinema

Charlottenborg Art Cinema is the place to view established and experimental film art as well as documentaries that set the agenda for discussions today. This fall the programme presents the film club Blå Time curated by Emma Rosenzweig & Albert Grøndahl, a longer film programme in collaboration with CHART ART FAIR and special film screenings by Lotte Nielsen and Ben Russel among others.


